## **Company Background:**

#### **General Job Description:**

Under the administrative direction of the Operations Manager and technical direction of the General Manager, the General Superintendent (GS) supervises, manages, and leads multiple project Foremen and assumes responsibility for successfully executing multiple concurrent projects. The GS provides technical expertise to Foremen as required, and will monitor critical aspects of each project's performance and progress. The GS serves as the primary point of connection between field operations and management, and as such, works with program managers, project managers, and field engineers to ensure good communication through project completion.

The position will require significant regional (Northern CA) travel between project sites, and will be primarily field-based. Though highly infrequent, occasional overnight travel may be required.

#### **Essential Duties:**

- Directly manage 3-8 Foreman-Level employees, and assists them in the management and operations of their crews (typically 5-8 personnel per crew).
- Assumes primary responsibility for the projects technical execution.
- Oversees 3-8 concurrent projects at multiple locations at any given time.
- Acts with integrity demonstrating support for the company, its values, and the employees, while maintaining a constant focus on meeting or exceeding customer and inspector's requirements and expectations.



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- Orders and manages project materials and deliveries.
- Manages equipment and resources, coordinates equipment rentals when required.
- Coordinates inspections, tie-ins, and other milestone activities with all appropriate entities.

## **Minimum Qualifications:**

- 3+ years' experience as a lead Superintendent on construction projects.
- 5+ years' experience on gas pipeline construction (low pressure distribution lines).
- Able to make decisions under tight deadlines.
- Able to organize people, tools, and equipment and plan/manage multiple activities to accomplish desired results.
- Demonstrated leadership skills with ability and willingness to face challenges, direct others and effectively address conflict.
- Demonstrated commitment to quality by evaluating project-related processes and making necessary changes to improve efficiency.
